Hello again! Can you believe that it is September already? We have no school on Monday as this is Labor Day. We will see everyone here on Tuesday, September 5.

We have another busy month planned here at LPE. On **September 7**, the classes of Wells and Parish, and on September 8, the classes of Turgeau and Collins, will be hosting a Buddies' Breakfast and a math and literacy morning. Parents are invited to attend. If eating breakfast, complete the reservation form and send it to the teacher. If you are not eating breakfast, be at the school for 8:15. The math and literacy activities will take place in the classrooms.

The students are to come to school in uniform. On **September 15**, the pre-k classes will host a Buddies' Breakfast and math and literacy morning. If you are eating breakfast, do not come to the school until 8 a.m. You must have turned in your reservation sheet beforehand. If you are only coming to Math and Literacy morning, you may arrive after 8:30 a.m. This will all take place in the cafeteria. There will be no performances for k or pre-k classes.

Our Grandparents' Day for our **pre-k** grandparents will take place on **September 11 at 2:30 p.m.** The activities are going to take place in the classrooms for all of kindergarten on **September 12 at 2:30 p.m.** All grandparents need to be at the school at **2:15** and go to the

office to sign in. This requires a picture id. Parents, **if you are not allowing** your child to be picked up by a grandparent, you will need to send us a note before school on your child's class date.

"Be Here Week" will be the week of **September 18**. We always encourage our children to come to school, be at school on time, and stay all day. We really stress this during "Be Here Week" as a reminder to all of us the importance of school. Those that are at school all day, every day will get an extra recess on **Friday, September 22**. We know that there are circumstances that are beyond your control and you may have to keep your child home. We understand. There will be a "Be Here Week" every month. Also, we need a note from you if your child is absent and, if your child is sick more than three consecutive days, we need a doctor's note in order to excuse the absences.

In place of fundraisers through the school, other than PTA and pictures, we are asking that you collect and send in any of the following that you get: Boxtops for Education, Labels for Community Coffee proofs of purchase, Tyson and Best Choice UPC codes. Please remind family members to save them for us too!
